Signature Resolution adds four neutrals in San Diego

Signature Resolution added four neutrals to its office in San Diego, the firm announced Tuesday.

“We are cementing ourselves in the San Diego area and bringing a higher level of dispute resolution than the area has ever seen,” Signature Resolution managing partner Dario Higuchi said in a prepared statement.

Ronald S. Prager spent 29 years on the San Diego County Superior Court, 22 of which he spent presiding over complex civil cases. He

was a mediator at Judicate West from 2017.

Anthony F. Pantoni had been a litigator for 40 years specializing in labor and employment law. He was a partner at now-dissolved Brobeck, Phleger & Harrison until 1994 when he became an employment law and alternative dispute resolution sole practitioner.
